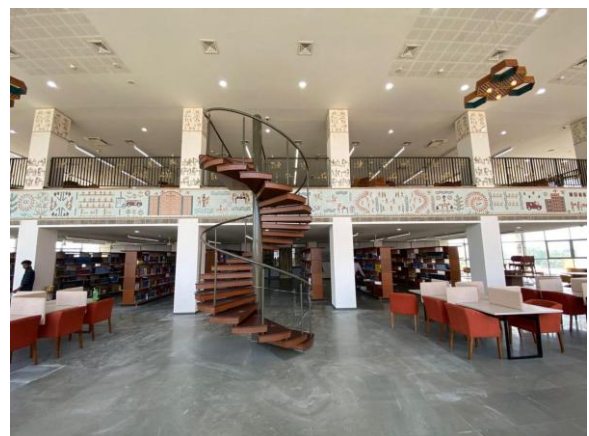

1. Applicants satisfying the eligibility criteria in all respect can submit their application only through ON-LINE mode. No documents, including the Registration Slip of the online application form, are required to be sent in Physical form. All the applicants are advised to keep a copy of the registration slips with them, along with proof of payment, for their records.
2. Applicants if not selected for Regular posts will be considered for Short term contract basis as per the merit.
3. Correction in registration details will not be considered through any mode i.e. e-mail/letter. Hence candidates are advised to fill their registration form carefully as no correction will be allowed after online submission of the form.
4. The candidature of applicants who fail to complete the online application by the stipulated date and time will not be considered. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
5. Those applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must fulfil all the eligibility criteria as on or before the closing date of online submission of applications. Required educational qualification/experience should be completed on or before the last date of the online submission of the application. In the case of educational qualification, the candidate should have completed the residency period for the desired educational qualification as well as have been declared successful in the final examination, on or before the last date of online application submission. Likewise, the candidate must have completed the duration of desired experience wherever applicable on or before the cut-off date, i.e. last date of submission of the online application.
6. Research Publication means only original papers, meta-analysis, systematic reviews, and case series that are published in journals indexed in Medline, PubMed Central, Science Citation Index, Citation Index, Expanded Embase, Scopus or Directory of Open Access Journals and other such journals as may be specified by the National Medical Commission from time to time.
7. Applicant may apply for more than one post code if they meet the eligibility criteria for the post/s.
8. Cut-off date to determine eligibility in terms of the age of candidates will be the last date for Online submission of applications.
9. All applicants must note that it is assumed that you are in possession of all required certificates to substantiate your eligibility on the day of the online application/day by which is required to be submitted at the Institute as per validity published in this notice. 15. For UR posts available, candidates of any category can apply (provided they meet the age criteria and experience criterion as applicable to UR candidates).
16. For positions mandating prior experience, the experience should have been acquired after successfully completing the essential qualification specified in the Recruitment Rules for the respective post. Moreover, the desired duration of experience must have been completed on or before the last date of online application.
17. Required teaching/research experience should have been acquired from an institution recognized by NMC/DCI/UGC as applicable. For any experience to be considered valid other than these, the Scrutiny Committee's decision will be final.

The Institute will use a set of objective criteria for short listing candidates to be called for interview for this recruitment.

All prospective candidates should go through these criteria before submission of online application for the post/s.

- (i) Stage 1 of Scrutiny: All applications meeting the age criteria, essential educational qualifications and experience requirements for the post will be shortlisted in first stage.
- (ii) Scrutiny and Short-listing of applicants: Further scrutiny using objective criteria will be done in those cases where the number of valid applicants after 1st stage Scrutiny for any one post is more than ten.
- (iii) Mandatory Supporting Documents: Candidates must upload supportive documents as proof of meeting the criteria which they have filled in online application. Failure to upload supportive documents will result in scoring for those criteria to be NIL.
